





## Assembly Instructions 3/10


#### **IMPORTANT**

- Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.
- Do not tighten all the bolts until each part is properly assembled.
- Keep Hex Wrench as the bolts may need to be tightened in the future.



### STEP 1

Insert Cam Lock Screws into pre-drilled holes in Back Rails (C), (D), Side Panels (G), (J) and Back Uprights (K), (L) then tighten. (See Figure 1)









### STEP 2

Attach Base (A) to Back Rail (D) with Cam Locks. (See Figure 2)






### STEP 3

Attach Back Uprights (K) and (L) to Back Rail (C).

Attach Middle Panels (H) and (I) to unit with Cam Locks.


### STEP 4







## STEP 5

Attach Front Rail (B) to unit with Head Cap Bolts.

Attach Supports (F) to unit with Cam Locks and Head Cap Bolts (middle).

### STEP 7

Attach Towel Bars to unit with Head Cap Bolts (short).

Attach Casters to unit with Flat Washers, Spring Washers and Head Cap Bolts (short), with Locking Casters at front, tightening bolts only halfway. (See Figure 4)

Tighten all Head Cap Bolts (short).




## Assembly Instructions 7/10

#### STEP 8

Attach Hinges to Doors (N) and (O) with Wood Screws (short) into pre-drilled holes, then tighten. (See Figure 5)




### STEP 9

Attach Doors (N) and (O) to unit with Wood Screws (short) into pre-drilled holes, then tighten. (See Figure 6)

Attach Handles to Doors (N) and (O) with Machine Screws. (See Figure 7)

Insert Adjustable Pins into side panels and middle panels at desired level.

Place Shelves (E) into position.



#### **STEP 10**


Attach Drawer Front (P1) and Drawer Back (P2) to Drawer Side (P3) with Wood Screws (long).


Attach Drawer Side (P4) to unit with Wood Screws (long).

Attach Drawer Bottom (P5) to unit with Wood Screws (short).



#### **STEP 13**


Attach Drawer Front (Q1) and Drawer Back (P2) to Drawer Side (P3) with Wood Screws (long).






## Assembly Instructions 10/10

#### **STEP 16**

Attach Top (W) to unit with Head Cap Bolts (middle).

Slide Drawers (P) and (Q) into position.

Note: Supports (V) from 20 09100 Top carton are not used in this assembly.




#### **STEP 17**

If needed, adjust doors up or down by removing the front Wood Screws (short) and loosening slightly the back Wood Screws (short) from side panel, adjusting doors up or down and re-installing screws. (See Figure 8).

If needed, adjust doors left to right. (See Figure 9)

If needed, adjust doors front to back. (See Figure 10)
