LOCATION REQUIREMENTS

### **A WARNING** Explosion Hazard Keep flammable materials and vapors, such as

Failure to do so can result in death, explosion, or fire.

1. It is recommended not to install the beverage center near an oven, radiator, or other heat source.

2. Do not install in a location where the temperature will fall below 55 °F (13 °C). For best performance, do not install the beverage center behind a cabinet door. 3. The beverage center should be located on a firm, flat surface that is strong enough to support the beverage center when it is fully loaded.

4. Leave a minimum of 1/2" (1.27 cm) between each side of the appliance

and the wall. The top and back of the appliance should have a minimun

1.5" (3.81 cm) clearance. This allows for proper air circulation. This appliance is intended to be free-standing and should not be built-in or placed in arecessed area. 5. The beverage center legs must be adjusted during installation in order to function properly. The leveling legs on the front corners can be adjusted by turning clockwise to raise the appliance, and counter-clockwise to lower it. Be sure to have the appliance sloped slightly backward to ensure that the door closes tightly.

6. Do not put the unit in a place where it is subjected to sunlight. 7. Do not put the unit in a palce where the ambient temperature is more than 90 °F (32 °C).

Before using the beverage center for the first time, remove all of the packing materials, including the foam base and adhesive tape holding

accessories in place.

Before using for the first time it is recommended to allow the unit to cool to the set temperature before loading cans in the unit. Also Load 1 shelf of cans and allow the unit to cool before adding another shelf of cans. BEVERAGE STORAGE

1. The maximum capacity of GLB36MS2F07 is 96 cans (4 oz/116 ml) as shown In order to achieve the maximum capacity, arrange the 30 cans in top three rows as shown in Figure A. 3. Arrange the 34 cans in bottom rack as shown in Figure B.



4. Store beverages in sealed containers only.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

# **A WARNING**

Electrical Shock Hazard
Plug into a grounded 3 prong outlet.
Do not remove ground prong. Do not use an adapter.
Do not use an extension cord.
Failure to follow these instructions can result in death, fire, or electrical shock.

1.Allow beverage center to stand upright for 4 hours before using.

2.Plug beverage center into a grounded 3 prong outlet. (See "Grounding instructions"). 3.Operate the beverage center by adjusting the temperature control buttons (up and down arrows) to various settings. The adjusting temperature range is 32  $^{\rm o}{\rm F}$ to 61 °F (0 °C to 16 °C).

Touch this pad once ( $\Lambda$ ) and the temperature will increase 1 °F (1 °C). Touch this pad once (  $\vee$  ) and the temperature will decrease 1 °F (1 °C). The new desired temperature will flash on the display for five seconds and then back to the actual temperature which will gradually change until the set point Touch this pad (°C/°F) and the temperature display will switch between °C & °F.



4.It is recommended not to open the door frequently to minimize the power

CLEANING



 Clean the interior of the appliance with a mixture of warm water and baking soda, use about 1-2 tablespoons per quart of water. • Use a sponge or soft cloth and make sure to wipe excess moisture out before cleaning around the controls. • Rinse thoroughly with warm water and dry with a clean soft cloth.

Clean the exterior surface with warm water and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly and dry with a clean, soft cloth. Door Gasket

The door gasket must be kept clean to ensure a proper seal. Make sure to clean the gasket frequently with the method as described above for exterior cleaning.

POWER FAILURE several hours. Do not put additional food into the appliance during a power failure, and avoid opening the door. Disconnect the plug from the outlet, and

econnect when the power has been restored. VACATION Before leaving on any vacation, remove all open beverage while you are gone. If you

plan to be gone for an extended period of time, it's recommended that all of the beverage should be removed from the appliance and it should be turned off and unplugged from the outlet. Clean the interior according to the directions provided in the Cleaning section of this manual, and leave the door open.




