

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DEFINITIONS

MOUNTING SYSTEM: A MOUNTING SYSTEM is the primary Chief product to which an accessory and/or component is attached.







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Assembly And Installation

Secure Brackets onto Soundbar

- Look at the mounting holes on the back of soundbar to determine install method. (See Figure 1)
 - Option A: Rivets with a manufacturer's supplied hanger bracket
 - · Option B: Keyhole slots
 - · Option C: Threaded inserts



Option A

 Attach two soundbar brackets (A) to soundbar's hanger bracket with two knobs (D) and two keyhole screws (C). (See Figure 2)



Option B

- Assemble knobs (D) and keyhole screws (C). (See Figure 3)
- Attach the soundbar brackets (A) to soundbar using the knob assemblies. (See Figure 3)



IMPORTANT!: If needed, use fender washers (B) under soundbar bracket (A) to rest flat onto the soundbar surface. (See Figure 4)



Option C

 Attach the soundbar brackets (A) to soundbar using two screws (K, L or M) and two washers (F or G). (See Figure 5)



IMPORTANT!: If needed, use fender washers (B) under soundbar bracket (A) to rest flat onto the soundbar surface. (See Figure 6)



Install Soundbar Bracket to TV Mount

CAUTION: Refer to mounting system's installation instructions to remove display and uninstall mount from display.

- 1. If already mounted, remove display from wall.
- 2. If already installed, uninstall mounting bracket display.
- Determine which screw diameter fits your display M4, M5, M6 or M8.
 - For displays with a rounded/irregular/obstructed back, longer screws (R, S, T, U or V) and TV spacers (Q) must be used. (See Figure 7)



CAUTION: Verify adequate thread engagement with your screw/washer/spacer combination and all brackets.

IMPORTANT!: To offset the shift in height of your mounting system due to the soundbar brackets (A), mount spacers (E) must be used in the top hole locations. (See Figure 7)



 Use four selected screws (K, L, M, N, P, R, S, T, U or V), four washers (F, G, H or J), two mount spacers (E) and TV spacers (Q) (if necessary) to secure mounting system and soundbar brackets (A) to back of display. (See Figure 8)

IMPORTANT!: Larger washers (H or J) must be used unless they do not fit the TV bracket.

IMPORTANT!: Soundbar MUST NOT be mounted above the display.

NOTE: Mounting system shown in Figure 8 is an example. Exact mounting configuration will vary based on mounting system.



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Adjustments

 Adjust both arms of soundbar brackets (A) until soundbar is in desired position. (See Figure 9)

NOTE: Repositioning the hole locations in the soundbar brackets (A) may be necessary to reach desired position.

IMPORTANT!: The final position of the soundbar must be within 2" (51 mm) of the display.

NOTE: When positioning the soundbar, make sure the control buttons on soundbar are accessible.



CAUTION: The middle connection of soundbar brackets (A) must not extend beyod the edge of the display. (See Figure 10)



NOTE: The soundbar brackets (A) should be positioned as vertically as possible. (See Figure 11)



2. After the soundbar is in the desired position, tighten all screw and knob connections. (See Figure 12)


