

# CENTER SUPPORT SYSTEMS FOR BEDS WITH **WOOD SIDE RAILS**

## FULL, QUEEN, KING AND CALIFORNIA KING CENTER SUPPORT MODEL NO: GS-3 XS


The GS-3 XS CROSS SUPPORTS have been pre-assembled at the factory. To insure proper installation, please check to make sure the angle iron cross supports are threaded into the Super Clamp/Leg assembly as shown in picture above before proceeding.



center GS-3 XS Cross Support. Make sure all the clamps are facing the same direction.

#### STEP TWO

Extend the GS-3 XS Cross Supports to the wood side rails. Make sure the GS-3 XS Cross Support is fully seated on the lip of the rail. Be sure that the GS-3 XS Clamp is located in the center of the bed (refer to FIG. 2). Loosely tighten the "L" bolt on the super clamps (refer to FIG. 3) - DO NOT TIGHTEN COMPLETELY UNTIL ALL OTHER ADJUSTMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE.





# FULL, QUEEN, KING AND CALIFORNIA KING CENTER SUPPORT MODEL NO: GS-3 XS

#### **STEP FIVE**

Attach the X-BRACE to the legs of the GS-3 XS Cross Supports and leg assembly using the Slotted Head Screw and Locking Hex Nut (refer to FIG. 6). Finger tighten the locking hex nuts until all final adjustments have been made. All three GS-3 XS Cross Supports will now be locked together (refer to FIG. 7). Make sure the Super Clamps are centered in the bed and that the center GS-3 XS Cross Support is center between the headboard





#### **STEP SIX**

Attach the GS-3 XS Cross Supports to the center support bearer rail (wood lip on lip on inside of wood rails) as shown in FIG. 8.




After attaching the GS-3 XS Cross Supports and checking to make sure that nothing has moved, tighten the "L" bolts firmlysecuring the Super Clamp to the GS-3 XS Cross Supports. TIGHTEN ALL REMAINING HARDWARE.







WOOD FLOOR



Adjust threaded glides to touch the floor as shown in FIG. 9.
